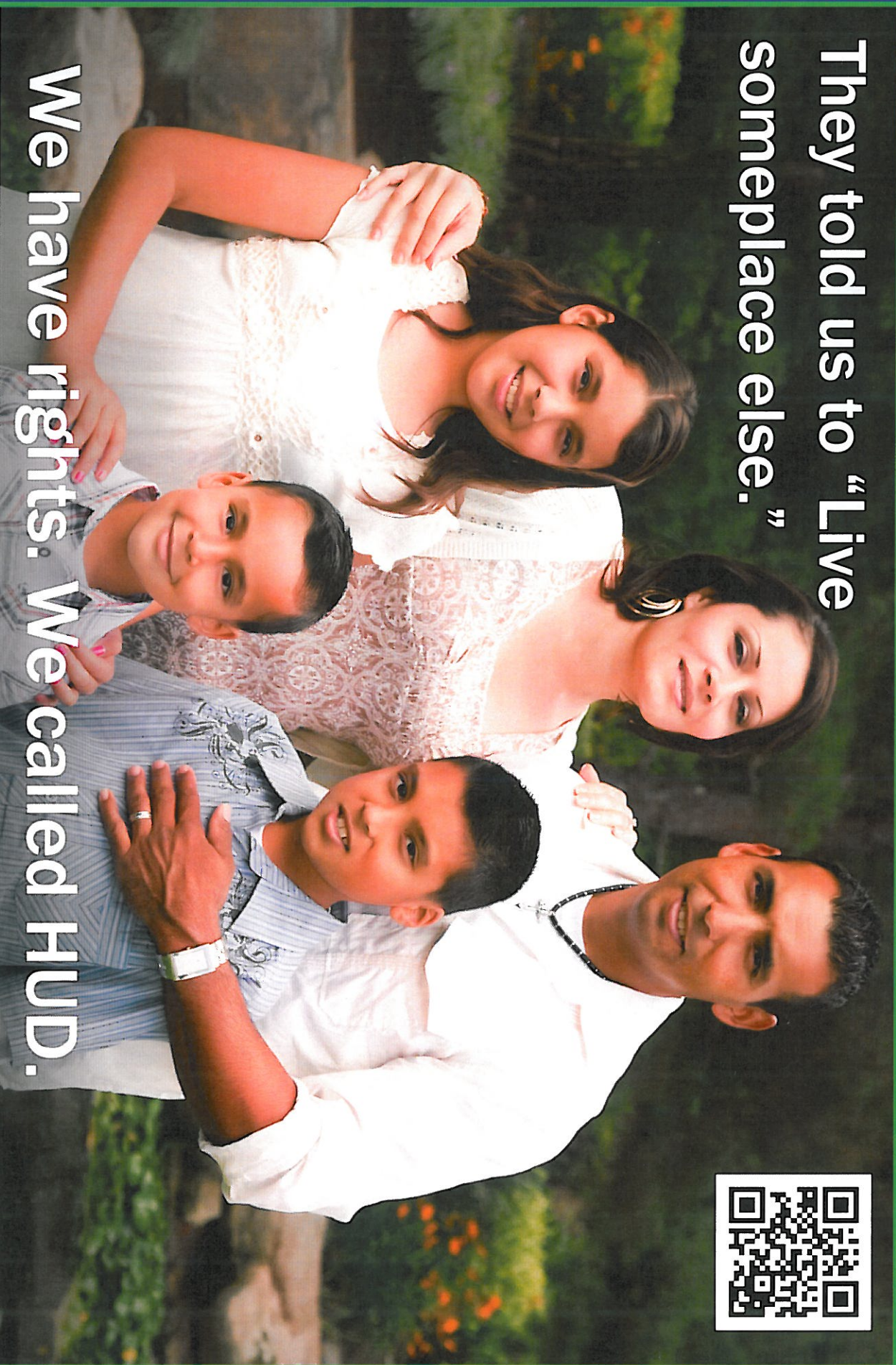


They told us to “Live

- Allowing only one child per bedroom
- Charging a higher security deposit for families with kids
- Limiting families with children to the first floor or certain buildings
- Refusing to rent to families with children

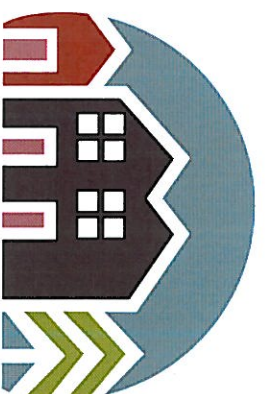
